What is the PPNIB Competition? –

The PPNIB Competition encourages community green projects, impressive floral displays and important environmental improvements in the Pelton Parish area. The aim is to create a more attractive environment in which we can all live, visit and work. The competition is open to all individuals, groups and organisations throughout the Pelton Parish area.

Only gardens viewable from a public highway or footpath are eligible,
(does not apply to allotments or schools).

Who can enter the competition?

These are the 4 different categories that you can enter-

1. School, Community Building or Business Frontage
2. Neighbourhood Area or Group Project
3. Garden or Yard
4. Allotment/kitchen garden. If you don't have a garden, you can use plant pots, containers, window boxes or hanging baskets for your displays viewable from a public highway or footpath.

How do I enter?

All residents will have a Parish Council Newsletter delivered in February/March 2024.
